THE ITINERARY

Wed.11th March – *Arrival at 4* Hotel Flora in the centre of picturesque Frascati and just few minutes from the train station with frequent connection to Rome Termini Central Station; check in and time at your disposal. At 6.00pm we will meet at the foyer for a welcome drink and presentation of the itinerary. At 7.30pm short walk from the hotel and dinner in a typical Trattoria Romana.

Thu.12th March – Buffet style breakfast. At 9.30 excursion to the picturesque ancient borough of Artena

<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Artena> We will have a wonder around the cobbled street of this beautiful hamlet and the surprise will be a visit to the “Museum of Rugby” described as one of the best Rugby Museum in the world <http://www.ilmuseodelrugby.it/> after the visit we will have lunch in the museum restaurant serving local typical cuisine; mid-afternoon return transfer to hotel Flora in Frascati and rest of the day at your leisure;

Fri.13th March – Buffet style breakfast. At 9.30 excursion to Tivoli and Villa D’Este for a day immerse in history, culture and the Grandeur of the beautiful 16th century Villa D’Este and its amazing formal gardens

https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Villa_d%27Este We will have lunch in a restaurant serving local traditional and typical cuisine. After lunch a stroll along the ancient part of Tivoli and about 4pm transfer back to Hotel flora in Frascati and rest of the day at your own leisure.

Sat.14th March – Buffet style breakfast. Today is match day with Kick Off at 5.45pm therefore it will be at your own leisure therefore, Rome here we come 😊 It is very easy to get to Rome from Frascati with the station just a short walk from our Hotel Flora and just a 30 minute journey by train (€2.10 each way timetable will be provided). Once arrived at Termini Station the easiest way to move around is by underground Line “A” for Piazza Navona and the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, Piazza del Popolo or San Giovanni in Laterano and Line “B”



for Colosseum. Getting to the Olympic Stadium is very easy by just following the crowd but depending where you are please, allow plenty of time to get there whether you walk, taxi or bus. Since the late K.O. and the last train available to Frascati from Rome Termini Station being at 8.54pm we are organising a taxi transfer back (time to be agreed) from tube station Anagnina the end of Line "A" which can be reached from the stations of Lepanto or Ottaviano 30 minute walk from the Olympic Stadium (full details will be given at your arrival in Italy); **We will purchase your ticket for Tribuna Monte Mario upon your booking, prices start from around £100 (Not Included in the cost) and as demand is very high we recommend you confirm as soon as possible (tickets must be paid in advance together with the 20% holiday deposit and are not refundable);**



Sun.15th March – Buffet style breakfast. Today will be completely at your own leisure and we are sure that many of you would like to take another opportunity to spend the whole day in Rome (train timetable will be provided with your information pack); In the evening we will meet at the hotel foyer 7.30pm and short walk to a local "Fraschetta" the typical local trattoria offering traditional and genuine roman cuisine;

Mon.16th March – Buffet style breakfast. At 10.00am transfer to visit a local bespoke winery, we will visit part of the vineyards, the cellars, production and of course we will taste some of their best wines accompanied by a light buffet; return to our Hotel Flora and rest of the day at your own leisure;

***Tue.17th March** – Buffet style breakfast. Today will be completely at your own leisure should you wish to spend more time in Rome or just relax and walk along the cobbled street of Frascati; *** There will also be the possibility to organise fantastic leisure Mountain Bike Rides through the vineyards and beautiful countryside as well as visits to other historic sites of interests like the Catacombs of "Ad Decimum", "Marino Sotterranea" and the San Nilo Abbey in Grottaferrata with lunch in a local restaurant (full list and costs of alternative tours and cycle ride available on request and dependant on number of participants);**
